Attendance and Punctuality

The school gates open at 7.45 a.m. and the campus is staffed from this time onwards. The school starts at 8.00 a.m. The gates are locked at 8.15 a.m. to ensure security of children and staff. If a child does not report on time, the fact will be recorded as "late" in the school calendar. The parent/guardian must inform the school by telephone call (or letter, or personal visit) if the child is going to be absent. Parents must be vigilant about their ward's regularity in attendance, failing which they are likely to fall behind in their academic growth. The school makes it a point to closely monitor the pupils' attendance and punctuality. Parents are expected to ensure that the child arrives at school on time. The school closes at 3.00 p.m.

Activity-based and Experiential Learning

St Aloysius Gonzaga School offers a comprehensive learning program that extends far beyond the confines of a classroom. In order to create a sustainable learning approach, we combine our curricula through contemporary teaching techniques, innovative problem-solving and questioning. COURSES *Offered*

Foundational Education (Pre-Kindergarten to Class II)

The National Educational Policy 2020 envisages education of children very early, as early as the age of 3 years. It is in the early years that the foundation for all future learning is laid. It is said that children learn more in the first six years than in the rest of their lives. Our school is well equipped to begin the "foundational education" through Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten to Class I & II, and thus to give the best possible start for later stages of education. Class I & II are very important years of schooling, and it is during these years that children learn the basic concepts which will be the cornerstone for the edifice of further learning. Parents are therefore exhorted to support their children especially in this foundational stage of learning.



Class XI and XII

Class XI and XII is a two year course. Students need to take only those subjects in class XI which he/she intends to continue in class-XII. In addition to English, which is compulsory, students will have to do four electives. From the following subject combinations, students could choose one.

Tests and Assessment

Throughout their time at St Aloysius Gonzaga School, a child's progress is tracked and assessed in a variety of ways. Children are regularly assessed with periodic tests and Term or Annual examination. At the end of the second term, the child's annual report, including assessment result, is sent to the parents. From time to time, the School holds "Open House" when parents can discuss with teachers the progress of the children. In case of need, parents are welcome to meet the child's teacher on Mondays or Wednesdays between 3.15 to 4.00 p.m., or any other day with prior appointment.



Admission Requirements

Pre-KG to Class 1

- a) The school is open for admission to both boys and girls - irrespective of caste, creed and social status.
- b) The minimum age requirements as on 01st June are: 3 years for Pre-KG; 4 years for KG I, 5 years for KG II and 6 years for Class 1.
- c) Original Birth Certificate from the City Corporation must be produced if the child has not attended school before.
- d) Those seeking admission to Class II and above are required to produce the Transfer Certificate from the previous recognized school.
- e) Two passport size colour photographs of the child should be attached to the application for admission.

Class XI and XII

Admission will be made on the basis of performance of students in Class X Board Examination by CBSE.

- School Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate issued by the Principal of the last school attended (Original).
- Self-attested photo copy of Mark Sheet of Class-X Board Examination.
- Copy of Aadhar Card
- Two Passport size photographs
- Original Migration Certificate
